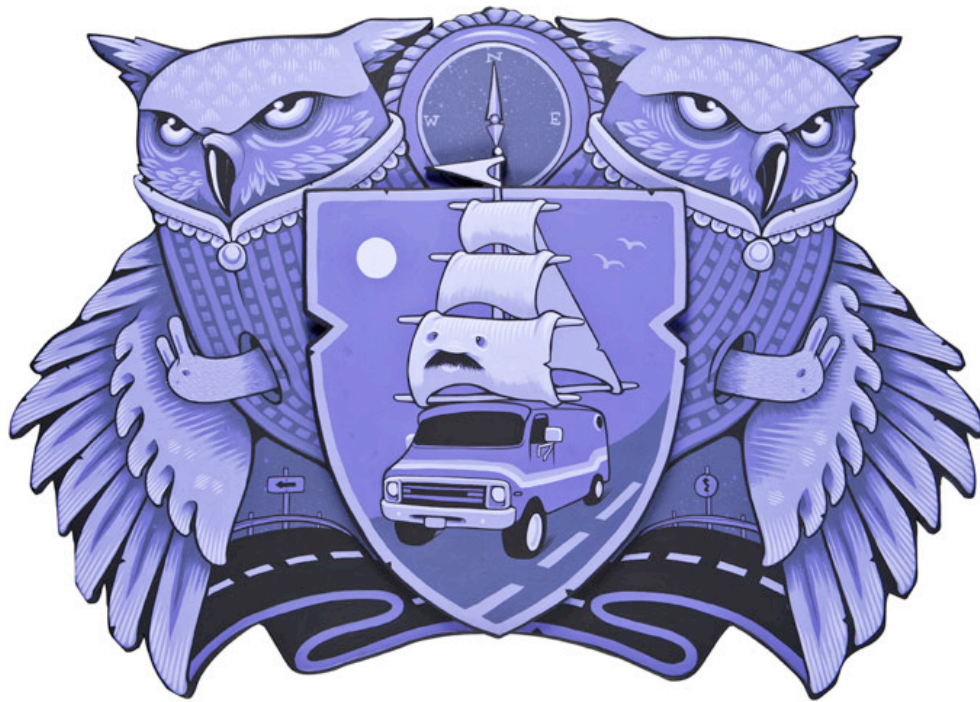


What were you up to in the year 2000?

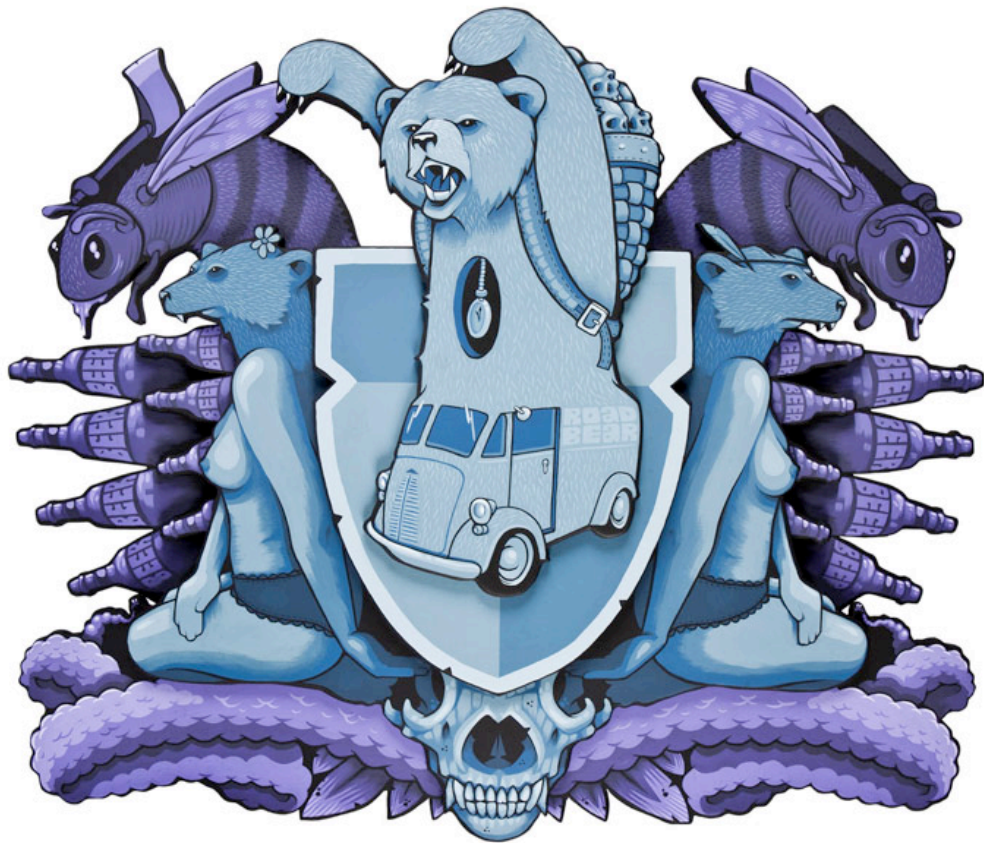


You making the opening at The Luggage Store on Friday September 10th? Love to see you.
